

# Patients:

Due to the recent Corona Virus Pandemic, please note the following:

If you answer yes to any of the following, let the receptionist know.

1. Have you recently experienced a fever of 100.4 or greater, or symptoms of acute respiratory illness such as a cough or shortness of breath?
2. Have you had recent travel (within the past 14 days) inside or outside of the United States?
  - a. If so, let the receptionist know the location of your recent travel and the dates of the recent travel.
3. Within the last 14 days, have you been exposed to the corona virus, COVID-19, OR an infectious person with a laboratory-confirmed diagnosis of COVID19, OR a person under investigation by the Center for Disease Control who has been ill?

Patients with COVID-19 have experienced mild to severe respiratory illness.

**Symptoms\* can include**

**FEVER**

**COUGH**

**SHORTNESS OF BREATH**

\*Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure.

If you have been in China or in close contact with someone with confirmed COVID-19 in the past 2 weeks and develop symptoms, call your doctor.
